#### **Outreach Ministries**

The final **Tripoli Mobile Food Pantry** was held on Thursday, October 21. Our 8 volunteers served 8 households, including 2 new households. While the Tripoli Mobile Food Pantry has ceased, area residents can visit the <u>Waverly Mobile Food Pantry</u> held between 4:30 and 6:30 pm on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of each month or the <u>Shell Rock Mobile Food Pantry</u> held between 4-5:30 pm, also on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of each month. Additionally, residents of Denver, Fairbank, Frederika, Maynard, Oran, Randalia, Readlyn, Sumner, Tripoli, and Westgate can visit His Hands Food Pantry in Oran. (See times and contact info below.) Those needing assistance from the Northeast Iowa Food Bank sponsored pantries are eligible to receive food from one mobile food pantry and one food pantry each month.

In September, <u>His Hands Food Pantry</u> in Oran served 55 households (560 individuals) and distributed 5,370 pounds of product. His Hands serves residents of Denver, Fairbank, Frederika, Maynard, Oran, Randalia, Readlyn, Sumner, Tripoli, and Westgate. Tuesday nights, 5-8 pm. Friday mornings, 9-noon.
