Opening Prayer: Pastor Marilyn.

Approval of the March 3rd minutes: Motion by Beth Goudschaal, to approve as stated, seconded by Brenda Shinstine

<u>Liaison Report:</u> Vicki met with the Memorial/Endowment committee on March 21st to better understand the funds and review them. They also attended the council meeting today. Endowments are set up for principal funds and the church is able to spend the interest. While Memorial funds are either designated or undesignated funds to use for the church. The council was reviewing who has authorization of the transactions of these funds. Working on getting a handout or brochure to give further details on these funds and share with the congregation. There are available seminars through Faith UCC to help educate any member on details of all church finances.

<u>Audit Report</u>: Big thank you to Brad Bunce and Shawntelle Moore for reviewing these reports and joining the audit committee. Motion to approve as stated Bonnie Travers, seconded by Conrad Marsh

Treasurer Report: Motion by Brenda Shinstine to approve as stated, seconded by Kathy Westendorf

<u>Trustee Report</u>: Alliant Energy - Energy Edge flow charts were reviewed they appear to support the nights/ weekends package. Alliant requested that we run for a couple months in the spring to confirm. (this would not be affected by the child care program, as this is only for the sanctuary).

Small Business Solutions – Still reviewing to see if we qualify. If so, we would be able to get a 70% return on those projects.

Black Hills Energy – There was a surcharge added back in 2021 due to the high cost of natural gas, since prices have dropped, this surcharge has been removed and will be a savings of about \$120/month.

Insurance – Community and Peoples Insurance have completed quotes. Once the quotes are picked up the trustees and council will review to confirm we have the best coverage at the best price.

Elder Report: Confirmation is set for May 7th. Recognizing Faith UCC's graduates is set for May 14th. Temporary Child Care – a business proposal was sent to the Council and Pastor to review. There are many things to consider and confirm to execute this plan for this summer. The council approved moving forward with this program if the data shows it to be profitable. If anyone is interested in volunteering or helping, please contact Traci Bahrenfuse or Helen Milius.

<u>Pastor's Report:</u> Pastor found a recipe for gluten free bread it was shared with council to taste test and approve. It was approved, it will help eliminate the noise with the crackers. Pastor wanted to thank Dave and Vicki for covering head usher duties during Lent. Pastor Marilyn will be out of the office April 10th - April 18th, Pastor Tyler is on call during her vacation. We will no longer be purchasing bulletins in an effort to save money. Discussed blessings and sacraments with those unable to join church.

Old Business: Louvers still need painted on the stemple. Money designated for this will most likely be completed by the property committee and volunteers.

New Business: None

Adjourn: Motion to adjourn by Beth Goudschaal, seconded by Bonnie Travers, motion carried.

The meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.
