The Visiting Nurses no longer use our space to provide vaccines. Outside groups no longer hold meetings here.

We are fortunate that last year and again this year we provide a day camp five days a week for area children. Monday thru Fridays become a bustling, exciting time! But is there more? What about for the other end of the age spectrum? Inviting area Seniors to use our Fellowship Hall a couple of afternoons a month (or more) to play cards or board games?

What about volunteering outside of the church building? There are many area organizations with opportunities for volunteers to share their time and talents. Do you currently volunteer? Would you be willing to share your story and invite others to join you? Brenda Sievers and I have been working on creating a system where area volunteer needs can be compiled and shared with the congregation in the hopes something might sound interesting for an individual or small group. What do you think?

During a recent discussion with a member around some of these same questions, they reminded me that we are an aging congregation and folks just can't do what they once did. I get that. I admit I am one of those who more frequently groans when I stand up...and runs out of energy early some evenings! But even within our limitations we can find ways to help others.

To quote a wise theologian — "A church with a strong mission environment is a stronger church." Together may we live fully into the stronger church God is calling us to be!
