Meeting called to order by Jerry Lahmann

Opening Prayer

<u>Approval of the October 7th Minutes:</u> Updates made and corrected. Sent revisions to Pastor. Motion to approve by Kathy Westendorf, seconded by Traci Bahrenfuse.

<u>Treasurer Report:</u> Motion to approve by Dave Kirchhoff. Seconded by Conrad Marsh. Add line items for interest and dividends received under 49510 Offerings, to differentiate between offerings and other debits.

Trustee Report: Working to get the Trustee's together to fix the entry way roof to the west end Ed building. Nest thermostat in the sanctuary of the church installed and functioning on a timer for both heat and air. If adjusted it will fault back to the preset temperatures. Looking into smart hours through Alliant to save additional funds. Church basement concerns with moisture, looking into corrective actions and finding where it is getting in. Pastor's agreement package should be reviewed annually, has not been completed. Solar system audit estimate, 22,500 watts, 50 panels, expected projection 30,297 kWh, total install would be \$67,500. There is 30% federal tax grant, and potential REAP grant bringing it down to roughly \$15,000. We currently have three separate accounts at Alliant. This option would need to be all on one account and metered together. The solar panels would also have to be set up on the ed building, 50 panels total. Looking into roof structure and additional

insurance needed to confirm total savings.

Elder Report: Sending a post card to all members stating we will be reaching out via a phone call to receive feedback and any ideas they have to help strengthen the church. Traci working on website and meeting with Steve and Pastor to discuss what they would like to see in the website. Advent activity, making a centerpiece, planning to do this on December 1st.

Pastor's Report: None.

<u>Old Business:</u> By-laws reviewed and updated. Motion to approve by Traci Bahrenfuse. Seconded by Dave Kirchhoff.

<u>New Business:</u> American Savings Bank requested a formal form for the President and Vice President to sign to allow Ruth Kirchhoff to manage the Memorial Committee CD's and funds.

Motion to adjourn by Dean Shinstine, seconded by Jerry Lahmann.

The meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.
