

Opening Prayer

Approval of the December 2nd Minutes: Motion to approve by Eli Bahrenfuse, seconded by Conrad Marsh.

<u>Treasurer Report:</u> Pastor approved two payments on vacation payout if needed to ensure funds are available. Motion to approve by Dean Shinstine and seconded by Vicki Oleson.

<u>Trustee Report</u>: Budget adjusted for next year. Left Pastor pay the same, will circle back if more funds needed for pulpit supply. Raise given to Office Assistant to \$15/hr. She confirmed she will help out with transition as Pastor exits. Increased pulpit supply from \$500 for the year to \$4,800. Current rate \$.70 cents a mile and \$200/ service. Working with local retired pastors and conference to line up fill ins.

Increased yearly pay for video streaming from \$2,000 to \$2,600 for the year.

Add a line item for parsonage repairs and maintenance with a budget of \$2,000 for the year.

Utilities were reduced by \$4,000 for the year. Budget for 2025 is \$158,811.55.

Motion to approve by Vicki Oleson. Seconded by Traci Bahrenfuse.

Working to obtain new cell phone with Pastor's retirement. Sharon McLavey to work with Barb Hill to complete obtaining a cellphone at US Cellular.

Elder Report: Annual Report submitted.

Pastor's retirement party will be Sunday January 26th celebrating after church service during fellowship with the Confirmand. Plan for the open house in the afternoon for the community

Open house Sunday January 26th 2-4pm. Traci will add to the website. Traci will call Tripoli Leader. Announce at Grace Lutheran through a service or note in their bulletin – Kathy to contact.
