God may not answer our prayers the way we expected or wanted, but we continue to pray. Prayer is communication between heaven and earth. Prayer leads us to a deeper understanding and to spiritual growth. Jeremiah 33:3 says "Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and hidden things that you do not know."


