<u>Trustee Report</u>: Church Basement update: Holthouse has not contacted Dave Kirchhoff, Mike put Extension on down spouts to run it away from the church. Narthex AC needs to be replaced, possible next spring. Endowment CD interest, returns (%5) from that going into operating budget, should we consider let the interest go back and accrue back in the CD.
